Deployed the 1 st and 2 nd sets of extenders along					
one side of the patient's upper body.					
Deployed the 1 st and 2 nd sets of extenders along					
the opposite side of the patient's lower body.					
Inserted hands into the handles and, in unison,					
pivoted the patient in the bed.					
Deployed extenders opposite of those first					
deployed.					
In unison, two patient attendants at one end of					
the patient pulled the patient approximately					
one-half way off of the bed.					
Remaining patient attendants insert hands into					
handles and, in unison, pulled the patient fully					
off the bed.					
Verbalized the need to prevent the patient from					
dropping during the transfer.	(]]

Deployed the 1 st and 2 nd sets of extenders from					
both sides of one end of the patient.					

With one patient attendant on each side of one		
end of the patient, inserted hands into the		
handles and, in unison, pulled the patient		
approximately one-half way off of the bed.		
Deployed the 1 st and 2 nd sets of extenders from		
the opposite end of the patient.		
With two patient attendants on each side of		
both ends of the patient, inserted hands into		
the handles and, in unison, pulled the patient		
fully off of the bed.		
Verbalized the need to prevent the patient from		
dropping during the transfer.
